



# DRIVE-IN CHURCH SERVICE

We are looking forward to welcoming you to our Potter Valley Bible Church (PVBC) Drive-In/Outdoor worship broadcast service!

## ARRIVAL

For the summer months, services will begin at 9:00am but plan to arrive 10-15 minutes early to answer some screening questions and to allow for vehicle parking. Services are being held at the old Rodeo grounds near Busch Creek in Potter Valley. Google map directions can be accessed on our website.

Upon arrival, a deacon will direct you to the drive-in parking area or to one of two outdoor parking areas.

## WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

### DRIVE-IN SERVICES

Drive-in Services allow you to listen via your AM radio. There are also a few outdoor speakers to further enhance the sound.

Upon arrival, a parking attendant will direct you to your parking location and inform you of the appropriate AM channel.

At the conclusion of the service, parking attendants will again help you exit in an orderly fashion.

### OUTDOOR/IN-PERSON SERVICES

If you choose the outdoor/in-person option, you will be directed to the appropriate parking

location and an usher will seat you in the designated area. For their protection, at risk individuals desiring the in-person option will be provided with a separate parking, seating and restroom facility.

## FACIAL COVERINGS

Please remember that facial coverings are not to protect you, but others.

Generally, facial coverings do not need to be worn inside your vehicle OR while in your designated outdoor space. While the intention is that everyone remain in their vehicle or in their designated family space during the entire service, there are some situations where this is not possible and where facial coverings\* must be worn/social distancing followed. Those situations apply to adults/children age of 3 and over and include:

- For anyone singing while attending the Outdoor/In-Person services
- If you are speaking to someone standing outside the vehicle (like a parking attendant) facial coverings shall be worn by both people
- To leave your vehicle or designated family space to use the restroom
- Any staff helping with the service, including anyone singing outside of a vehicle

If you need a facial covering, please let the deacon at the entrance know and one will be provided. Please don't hesitate to contact us should you have further questions.

## RESTROOM FACILITIES

We encourage everyone to use the restroom before leaving home but if you need to use one, there are 3 different porta potties located nearby with sanitizing stations outside. Separate porta potties are designated for the following people groups. Please make sure to use the restroom specifically designated for your group:

1. Drive-In
2. General: Outdoor/In Person
3. High Risk: Outdoor/In-Person

Out of love for others, and for their safety, please refrain from using the restroom for high-risk individuals if you do not identify as high-risk personally. When using the restroom, please maintain at least 6 feet of social distancing. *\*Also for enhanced sanitation, please use hand sanitizer before and after use.*

## AFTER THE SERVICE

**DRIVE-IN SERVICE:** Please do not exit your vehicle to socialize after the service. You may fellowship with those in the vehicle next to you, while remaining in your vehicle. The deacons will help you exit in an orderly manner.

**OUTDOOR SERVICE:** Please refrain from physical contact and maintain appropriate social distancing.

## SYMPTOMS

If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms\*, have been in recent contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, or have been personally diagnosed with COVID-19 recently, we ask that you refrain from attending. *\*Symptoms include: frequent cough, fever of 100.4 or higher, difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, or a recent loss of taste or smell.*

## HELPFUL TIPS

- **You may wish to fuel up your car before the service.**
- **You might want to bring sunscreen or additional shade (possibly a blanket to sit on) and maybe something to eat or drink.**
- **Family Resources.** During this time, children are to stay with their families. You may wish to make preparations ahead of time. by bringing something age appropriate that might help them follow along. Resources can be accessed on our website.
- **Have your worship music lyrics ready.** Have your worship lyrics accessible when you get settled in your parking spot. Worship music happens right after the Call-to-Worship Scripture Reading (after announcements). Ensuring you have your printed lyrics or website lyrics available helps with a more streamlined flow. Lyrics are available on our webpage.
- **Submit any prayer request or praises beforehand.** Since corporate prayer time looks a little different than we are used to, make sure you let us know if you have any prayer requests or praise reports before the

Drive-In service so we can share those with everyone.
